*Instructions:*

Measures 1-4

S.A.

1st time: Solo

2nd time: Solo, sopranos, and altos follow approximately 2 counts after in random order.

*Repeat cantus firmus 3 more times to build in texture before continuing to measure 5.*

Measures 36-39

S.A.

1st time: Altos only, singing in random order

2nd time: Sopranos join altos, singing in random order Repeat 2 more times before continuing to measure 40

T.B.

Hold notes until measure 40

*Recommendation: Conductor conducts in time to signal tenor/bass after repeat*

*Composer Note:*

*Dona Nobis Pacem* is inspired by the famous subject line from William Byrd's *Mass for Four Voices*. Having sung this piece multiple times, Byrd's use of dissonance building off this single line before concluding the final piece is almost addicting to listen to. I found myself wondering what it would sound like to lean into this dissonance of this subject line becoming its own canon that builds into an entirely new piece and lead to the creation of this piece.
